

POMORSKIE AS A LEADER!







Dear Friends,

Currently the largest challenge of self-government in the Pomorskie Region related to our region's presence in the European Union is efficient implementation of the Regional Operational Programme of Pomorskie Region for 2014-2020. For over a year the Pomorskie Region has been a leader in the ranking of effective exploitation of EU funds in Poland, surpassing both regional programmes carried out by self-governments of the other voivodeships and national programmes implemented by the central government.

So far we have signed 1075 agreements with a total value of PLN 7.3 billion. In this manner we have already contracted 69% of the budget within the Regional Programme of the Pomorskie Region. In the coming months and years, new investments in the region are and will be an effect of the concluded agreements, e.g.: the development of innovations in companies, construction or reconstruction of roads and railway lines, thermal modernisation of buildings, new buildings and equipment for hospitals, revitalisation of cities, training sessions and courses activating the unemployed, grants for setting up businesses, new places for children in kindergartens, and much more.

Effective use of EU funds by the region will also have a large influence on development of the Pomorskie economy in the near future. Beneficiaries of the Regional Programme are beginning execution of planned investments: buying equipment or ordering construction work and services – and this directly contributes to the dynamic economic growth of the Pomorskie region.

REGIONAL PROGRAMME 2014-2020

The Regional Operational Programme of Pomorskie Region for 2014-2020 (ROP of PR 2014-2020) is an investment programme aimed at taking up development challenges faced by the Pomorskie region in the economic sphere, education, professional and social activities, exploitation of the potentials of particular areas, the transportation system, health care, energy and the environment.

The ROP of PR 2014-2020 is one of the instruments for fulfilment of the Development Strategy of Pomorskie Region 2020 (DS of PR 2020). The thematic scope and intervention logic of the ROP of PR 2014-2020 are also determined by the content of six Regional Strategic Programmes (RSP) in the field of: economic development (Pomorskie Creativity Port), professional and social activity (Active Pomeranians), transport (Mobile Pomorskie), the energy industry and the environment (Eco-Effective Pomorskie), cultural and tourist attractions (Pomorskie Voyage) and health care (Health for Pomeranians), which are a direct response to the challenges diagnosed in the DS of PR 2020.


BUDGET OF THE PROGRAMME

The ROP of PR 2014-2020 is financed by European Union funds (EU) within the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and European Social Fund (ESF). Allocation of EU funds for the Programme amounts in total to PLN 7.5 billion*, including PLN 5.4 billion from the ERDF and PLN 2.1 billion from the FSF.

The value of EU funds in the ROP of PR 2014-2020 is almost twice as high as the Programme for 2007-2013, which makes it the largest, in the history of Pomorskie Region, investment programme administered by regional authorities.

* Thanks to efficient implementation of the Programme, it will be possible for the region to acquire additional funds in the amount of approx. PLN 480 million to be used for new investments in the region.








REGIONAL OPERATIONAL PROGRAMME OF POMORSKIE REGION FOR 2014-2020

THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT IN AXIS 1 - KNOWLEDGE COMMERCIALIZATION AND AXIS 2 - ENTERPRISES INCLUDES AN INCREASE IN THE COMPETITIVENESS AND INNOVATIVENESS OF POMERANIAN COMPANIES, THEIR INCREASED SHARE IN FOREIGN MARKETS, AS WELL AS IMPROVEMENT OF POMORSKIE REGION'S INVESTMENT POTENTIAL.

INNOVATION GRANTS

28 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 119.6 MILLION

Scope of support: financing the research and development work (R+D) of entrepreneurs, development of the R+D infrastructure of companies and their cooperation with scientific centres to develop innovative products or services.

Examples of projects:


- Marine Projects company in Gdańsk, thanks to a grant in the amount of nearly PLN 13.8 million, will conduct
 research into development of a project and construction of a prototype pusher tug with hybrid drive along
 with an innovative accompanying boat of varying immersion,
- ASSISTECH company in Gdańsk, thanks to a grant in the amount of nearly PLN 1.1 million, is implementing a project concerning developmental support of disabled children with the use of innovative therapeutic methods.

SUPPORT OF COMPETITIVENESS OF ENTERPRISES

113 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 168.3 MILLION

Scope of support: grants for companies to market new products or services, increased productivity of enterprises by applying information and communication technologies or eco-effective operations.

- Bertrand Bracia company in Luzino, thanks to a grant in the amount of over PLN 796 thousand, will increase competitiveness by marketing innovative windows for energy-efficient construction,
- Control Solutions company in Banino, thanks to a grant in the amount of over PLN 999 thousand, will activate an innovative service and assembly plant of robotised production lines.





PREFERENTIAL LOANS, GUARANTEES AND CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The Board of Pomorskie Region has signed an agreement with Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego (BGK) with a value of over PLN 408 million. It regards BGK's activation of repayable support for companies for development of innovative activities, including scientific and research operations, and to strengthening their competitiveness. The support provided by Financial Intermediaries selected by BGK will include loans, guarantees and capital contributions. Support of at least 2 thousand entrepreneurs will be an effect of the project's implementation, and further ones will obtain financial resources from funds returned.

POMERANIAN EXPORT BROKER

The objective of the project implemented by Agencja Rozwoju Pomorza S.A. (the Pomerania Development Agency) is creation of a comprehensive and coordinated support system of companies in the scope of export development. Services available for entrepreneurs include: acquisition of knowledge concerning legal, customs, tax, marketing issues or information about potential foreign cooperators. Entrepreneurs will also be able to receive a grant to take part in fairs or economic missions, benefit from intermediation and enter into cooperation with counterparties on foreign markets. The total value of the project comes to over PLN 84 million.

INVEST IN POMERANIA

The objective of the project is improvement of the region's investment potential, which will have a positive influence on the labour market and the growth of economic links between companies, including firms of the SME sector. A significant aspect of the project is development of the investor service system through implementation of investment support instruments, e.g. activation of a fund with financial resources for preparation of investment areas, investment promotion of the region and investment process service. The "Invest in Pomerania" project, implemented by the Pomerania Development Agency has a value of over PLN 195 million.







EDUCATION

OUT OF CONCERN FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS OF POMERANIANS!

THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT IN AXIS 3 - EDUCATION IS IMPROVEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL QUALITY AND REDUCTION OF DISPROPORTIONS IN THE ACCESS OF CHILDREN AND YOUTH TO EDUCATIONAL SERVICES IN THE POMORSKIE REGION.

PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION

71 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 107.9 MILLION

Scope of support: financing of the ongoing functioning of new pre-school upbringing centres, improvement of education quality in kindergartens by enriching the offer of classes, including additional courses (e.g. corrective, with a speech and language therapist or other specialists), adaptation of buildings and rooms, purchase of equipment and educational tools as well as courses, training and post-graduate studies for pre-school education teachers.

Exemplary project:

A project of Chojnice town with a value of PLN 1 million, aimed at creating additional 50 upbringing places in a kindergarten unit at School No. 7 in Chojnice. The project will include, for example: adaptation of rooms to meet pre-school education needs, purchase of equipment and educational tools. The project also aims at improving quality and extending the educational offer of other Pre-School Education Centres in Chojnice by organising additional classes in them. In total 200 children will be able to participate in the lessons.

QUALITY OF GENERAL EDUCATION 115 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 253.5 MILLION

Scope of support: preparation of children and youth for further stages of education and moving into the labour market, development of creativity and innovativeness of students as well as improvement of teachers' professional competency. The financing will also be allocated for fitting classrooms with equipment necessary for carrying out educational classes.

Exemplary project:

 A project of Słupsk city with a value of over PLN 4 million is addressed to 2663 students and 102 teachers at primary schools in Słupsk. Students who have learning difficulties will be participating in interactive maths workshops. In addition, participants of the above-mentioned classes will participate in educational trips and training on cyberbullying as well as creativity workshops. Students will also benefit from classes developing linguistic competency.

For students with special educational needs - dyslectics, children with a referral by a Psychological and Pedagogical Counselling Centre, disability certificates or referred to special educational activities - specialist therapeutic classes have been prepared. All schools will be fitted with multimedia equipment in the form of interactive boards with didactic software and projectors. Natural science classrooms will be additionally equipped.

SUPPORT OF PARTICULARLY GIFTED STUDENTS

27 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 30.2 MILLION

Projects carried out by the self-government of Pomorskie Region are oriented towards implementation of a system for support of particularly gifted students by means of scholarships. They also include support for the development of qualifications and competencies of teachers for work with gifted students.

- the project "Pomeranian scholarship programme 2015/2016 and 2016/2017" is dedicated to particularly gifted students in natural science, IT subjects, mathematics, foreign languages or entrepreneurship. It includes scholarships, distinctions for outstanding scholarship holders, seminars and courses for teachers, including such issues as creation of Individual Educational Programmes for Students (IEPS). The value of the project is almost PLN 3.5 million,
- the project "The Pomeranian Talent 2016-2021 concern for young geniuses". This is an innovative and unique project at the national level. It comprises 26 projects implemented by the self-government of Pomorskie Region in partnership with 19 counties and seven higher education schools. Its aim is to provide particularly gifted students from Pomeranian primary schools with assistance in their personal development. The support is granted to talented students both in physical sciences and the humanities. The value of all the projects comes to PLN 27.3 million.





VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND EDUCATION

WE SUPPORT VOCATIONAL EDUCATION OF YOUTH!

THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT IN AXIS 4 - VOCATIONAL EDUCATION (AND ACTIVITIES CONNECTED WITH IT WITHIN AXIS 3 - EDUCATION) IS TO INCREASE THE ATTRACTIVENESS AND QUALITY OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION OF YOUTH BOTH AT THE LEVEL OF VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AND HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.

NEW OFFER OF VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

46 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 361.9 MILLION

Scope of support: creation of a modern educational offer of vocational schools meeting labour market needs, changes in curriculum, organisation of cooperation with employers, professional traineeships, education of vocational teachers as well as equipping school classrooms and workshops.

Exemplary projects:

- a project of Wejherowo county is addressed to 1831 students,
 52 teachers and 2 instructors of practical vocational training in 8 schools,
- according to a project of Puck county, 470 students will be able to participate in internships and traineeships with employers, and 4 schools will be fitted with equipment necessary for carrying out classes.

INCENTIVE PROGRAMMES FOR STUDENTS OF VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

The project of the self-government of Pomorskie Region with a value of PLN 21.5 million is addressed to students of vocational schools which offer classes in key sectors in the region and fitting into the Pomeranian Smart Specialisations (PSS). The support is also addressed to vocational teachers and instructors of practical vocational training. Thanks to implementation of the project, 1850 students of vocational schools and centres will take part in internships and traineeships with employers. The best students will obtain scholarships.






6 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 89.8 MILLION

Scope of support: retrofitting of higher education schools with specialist didactic tools for the needs of practical education workshops as well as adaptation or modernisation of existing infrastructure.

- extension of a building of the Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Information Technology of the University of Gdańsk for the needs of education in the subject: "Practical IT", with the specialisation: "Web programmer".
- development of the practical education system within the Academic Centre in Słupsk – new specialisations will be created, e.g.: protection of cyberspace, programing in automatics and robotics, physicochemical materials engineering,
- new infrastructure and equipment
 of workshops for the needs of practical
 subjects (e.g. nursing, medical rescue, nutrition,
 physiotherapy) at the Medical University
 of Gdańsk and Pomeranian University
 in Słupsk.





EMPLOYMENT

WE INCREASE LABOUR MOBILITY!

THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT IN AXIS 5 - EMPLOYMENT IS PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATION OF THE UNEMPLOYED AND ENHANCEMENT OR CHANGE OF PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS OF WORKING PEOPLE, AS WELL AS PROPHYLAXIS CONCERNING EARLY DIAGNOSIS OF CANCER.

PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATION OF THE UNEMPLOYED 34 PROJECTS WITH VALUE OF PLN 52 MILLION

Projects aimed at increasing employment among unemployed people encourage them to take up a job outside their current place of residence by covering costs of travel, including costs of commuting to work, for interviews and by ensuring a relocation allowance, internships, traineeships aimed at gaining or complementing professional experience, courses and training to enhance, complement or change professional qualifications.

CARING FOR CHILDREN UP TO AGE 3

13 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 9.2 MILLION

The offered support within implemented projects is mainly to help parents of small children to take up a job by financing care over their offspring in nursery schools or paying for nanny remuneration. In nursery schools where new care places have been created, necessary retrofitting and equipment are purchased.

HEALTH ON THE LABOUR MARKET

3 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 12.3 MILLION

Health projects co-financed with EU funds aim at increasing the attendance rate at prophylactic examinations among residents of the region by raising awareness of the role of prophylaxis and healthy life-style in the prevention of cancer. Within the project, prophylactic examinations will be conducted in the scope of early diagnosis of cancers: breast cancer, cervical cancer and colorectal cancer.

LIFELONG LEARNING 89 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 135 MILLION

Lifelong learning financed within EU projects makes it possible to learn and improve skills on a constant basis as well as to adapt them to changing conditions on the labour market. This is made possible by participating in foreign-language courses, training in information and communication technologies, as well as classes enabling enhancement of qualifications of staff members who out of their own initiative are interested in acquiring, complementing or improving skills and competences.

ADAPTABILITY OF EMPLOYEES

The projects will support dismissed employees, to be made redundant or at risk of dismissal. Participants will receive assistance in determining a professional path, e.g.: through career counselling combined with preparation of an Individual Action Plan, a psychological consulting service, job consulting service, workshops or training including techniques of active searching for work and acquiring key competencies. Financial support will also be offered in the form of grants to start a business and support in the initial period of running it.

NEW MICRO ENTERPRISES 21 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 59.8 MILLION

Scope of support: grants for starting a business and substantive support which includes legal assistance, consultations, training and consulting service connected with running a firm in the initial phase.

Exemplary project:


 a project of the Pomerania Development Agency with a value of over PLN 2.8 million, which includes comprehensive support to set up a business by 64 unemployed women over the age of 30.



SUPPORT – ACTIVATION – REVITALISATION!



THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT WITHIN AXIS 6 - INTEGRATION IS PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATION AND SOCIAL INTEGRATION OF RESIDENTS OF THE POMORSKIE REGION AND IMPROVEMENT OF ACCESSIBILITY TO SOCIAL SERVICES. AXIS 8 - CONVERSION IS RESPONSIBLE, INTER ALIA, FOR FINANCING OF REVITALISATION ACTIVITIES OF CITIES AND RENOVATION OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS.



REVITALISATION OF CITIES

26 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 247.7 MILLION

Scope of support: revitalisation of selected areas of cities through professional activation and social integration of residents, reconstruction of public infrastructure and adaptation of facilities for the provision of social services and carrying out cultural activities.

Examples of projects:

4 integrated revitalisation projects of selected areas of the city of Gdańsk.
 247 people in total will be covered by support in the form of specialist services. They will help residents to find a job and integrate with society.
 Investments in infrastructure will complement social activities. For example renovations of buildings in which social services will be provided for residents will be completed. The value of all Gdańsk projects amounts to PLN 98.5 million.

By the end of 2017 agreements for financing of projects including revitalisation of districts of other cities of the Pomorskie region will be signed.

REVITALISATION LOANS

Thanks to an agreement signed by the Board of Pomorskie Region and the European Investment Bank (EIB), PLN 86.1 million from the ROP of PV 2014-2020 will be allocated for activation of repayable support for execution of projects aimed at revitalising Pomeranian cities. The intermediary, Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego, chosen by the European Investment Bank, will offer loans to the final recipients. Implementation of the EIB project will enable revitalisation of at least 15 ha of degraded urban areas.

SOCIAL ECONOMY

Projects oriented towards increasing employment in the social economy sector are implemented by accredited Social Economy Support Centres (OWES). Activities are carried out on the basis of diagnosis of a problematic situation, the resources, potential and needs through combined application of different types of services.

Exemplary project:

a project of the Association for Development of Debrzno
 Town and Municipality with a value of over PLN 9.5 million provides for
 an increase in employment in social economy entities in the following
 counties: chojnicki, człuchowski and kościerski. The activities will include
 e.g.: support of the development of partnerships and initiative groups
 for the benefit of social economy; searching for and supporting local
 social business leaders; incubation services, including activities aimed
 at acquiring professional competencies and qualifications; grants
 for the creation of jobs in social enterprises; bridge support in financial
 form and in the form of consulting services.

SOCIAL SERVICES

These are performed through initiatives within the scope of development of social services, addressed mainly to families at risk of poverty and social exclusion as well as persons reliant on care, including the chronically ill. The essence of the support is a departure from institutional care towards provision of personalised services in the local environment.

SOCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL ACTIVATION

The aim of the projects is to increase social activity and employment among people at risk of poverty or social exclusion, including persons with disabilities.

Examples of projects:

 a project of Tczew Municipality with a value of PLN 1.1 million is addressed to 80 unemployed people, vulnerable to poverty or social exclusion. Each participant of the project will be covered by support provided on the basis of an individual re-integration path. It will include: workshops within the scope of forming social competencies and moving into the labour market, psychological support, coaching, professional courses and internships.

INTEGRATION

The self-government of Pomorskie Region, with EU funds, offers a lot of activities for people who experience social exclusion, consisting both in work with families and integration of the local community. Participants of the projects will obtain support in the form of psychological consulting services, consultancy, training and professional internships, which increases opportunities for employment. Thanks to participation in the projects in the area of social and professional activation, the situation of these persons and their families may be decidedly improved.

PROTECTION OF THE CULTURAL HERITAGE

16 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 158.7 MILLION

Scope of support: restoration work, preservation work of historic buildings and their adaptation to new public functions.

- renovation and adaptation of St. John's Church in Gdańsk into the St. John's Centre,
- revitalisation and adaptation of two historic granaries from the 19th century and their surroundings for cultural and social purposes – Witkacy in the Słupsk Art Granaries,
- construction and assembly work within the Old Town in Gniew, together with land development of the castle moat.



FALTH

WE MODERNISE HEALTH SERVICES!

THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT IN AXIS 7 – HEALTH IS IMPROVEMENT OF RESIDENTS' STATE OF HEALTH IN THE POMORSKIE REGION THROUGH INVESTMENT IN INFRASTRUCTURE, HEALTH SERVICES, IMPROVEMENT OF ACCESS TO SPECIALIST MEDICAL SERVICES AND IMPLEMENTATION OF MODERN IT AND TELEMEDICAL SYSTEMS IN MEDICAL ENTITIES.

GERIATRICS CENTRES

2 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 37.2 MILLION

Scope of support: construction work in health care facilities, modernisation and purchase of specialist medical apparatuses and equipment as well as improvement of access to health services.

Implemented projects:

- Geriatrics Care Centre in Sopot. The project includes execution of construction work, purchase of specialist medical equipment (e.g. purchase of CT scanner, ECG and USG apparatuses), organisation of training for personnel and implementation of an integrated care model. The value of the investment amounts to PLN 25.3 million.
- Geriatrics Centre in Gdańsk. The project will include e.g.
 renovation and construction work, purchase of equipment
 for motor, cardiological and pulmonology rehabilitation.
 Medical equipment for diagnostics and therapy as well
 as systems for telecare, home-based tele-rehabilitation
 and monitoring of patients will be bought and specialist
 training for personnel will be organised. The value of the
 investment amounts to almost PLN 12 million.

HOSPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE

10 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 364.7 MILLION

Scope of support: construction work in health care facilities, modernisation and purchase of specialist medical apparatuses and equipment and improvement of access to health services.

- eight treatment rooms will be created in St. Adalbert Hospital in Gdańsk including e.g.: general surgery, orthopaedics, urology and gynaecology as well as a hybrid cardiosurgical room. A urological ward with a treatment room and urological endoscopy room and trauma and orthopaedic surgery ward will be formed. The project also includes expenditures on training and improvement of qualifications of medical staff, operation of an oncological helpline, psychological support, psychonocological support as well as creation and functioning of interdisciplinary teams. The value of the project amounts to PLN 83.3 million.
- Ceynowa Hospital in Wejherowo will have a new four-storey building with seven
 operating rooms. It will include angiology, vascular surgery and cardiological
 rehabilitation wards as well as the Endoscopy Centre. Additionally, a cardiological
 daily rehabilitation ward will be set up there, among others.
 The cost of the investment amounts to almost PLN 105 million.
- in the Kociewie Health Centre in Starogard Gdański the investment includes reconstruction of 5 hospital wards: neurological, cardiological, stroke, general surgery and internal disease wards. A rehabilitation centre, diagnostic imaging unit and 9 specialist clinics will be created in the renovated rooms. An operating block and central sterilization room will be set up in the new attached wing. The hospital will be retrofitted with specialist apparatuses (MRI scanner and CT scanner) and medical equipment. The value of the project amounts to PLN 48.6 million.

15 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 225.2 MILLION (INCLUDING THE "POMERANIAN E-HEALTH" PROJECT)


Scope of support: implementation of integrated e-health systems and telemedical services, including tele-rehabilitation, telecare, teleconsultation and telediagnostics.

Examples of projects:

- computerization of the Health Care Centre in Człuchów and the clinic in Chojnice.
 The value of the investment amounts to PLN 5.1 million,
- implementation of an electronic medical documentation system with transmission of image data in healthcare entities of the Słupsk sub-region. The cost of the investment amounts to PLN 7.9 million,
- e-Health in the Malbork-Sztum Functional Urban Area. The value of the project amounts to PLN 3.2 million.

POMERANIAN E-HEALTH

Digitization of healthcare entities' operations will be an effect of implementation of the project. This will ensure the compatibility of systems functioning within them and enable creation of a regional e-Health platform. Thanks to this, patients will gain access to, e.g.: medical documentation containing past visits, issued prescriptions, basic medical data, information on the need to conduct specialist examinations, including prophylactic ones. The Pomorskie Region is a leader of the project, and 16 healthcare entities for which Pomorskie Region is an establishing body are the units implementing the project. The total value of the investment amounts to PLN 184.1 million.


THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT WITHIN AXIS 9 – MOBILITY IS E.G. IMPROVEMENT OF THE EFFICIENCY OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN CITIES AND IMPROVEMENT OF ROAD AND RAILWAY CONNECTIONS BETWEEN IMPORTANT URBAN CENTRES IN THE REGION.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT - TRANSFER NODES

25 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 665 MILLION

Scope of support: creation of new and development of existing transfer nodes by building stops, shelters, car parks and parking for bikes, access roads to nodes as well as the purchase of new buses.

- construction of an integration node in Kościerzyna.
 The investment includes: revitalisation and adaptation of the railway station, land development of an integration node (e.g. construction of park&ride facility and a tunnel), construction of over 15 km of bike lanes and purchase of 10 buses. The value of the investment amounts to PLN 36.6 million,
- construction of an integration node in Słupsk.
 The project includes construction of a bus station linked by means of a tunnel with the railway station and parking.
 The passenger information system will be enhanced and an electronic ticket system will be introduced. The city of Słupsk will also buy 5 buses. The total value of the project amounts to nearly PLN 45 million,
- construction of an integration node Gdynia Karwiny.
 The project includes construction of a multi-storey park&ride, kiss&ride and bike&ride facility in the vicinity of a train stop of the Pomeranian Metropolitan Railway Gdynia Karwiny.
 Streets and sections of bike routes will be extended.
 The value of the investment amounts to PLN 68 million.

ROAD ROUTES AND RAILWAY LINES 11 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF OVER PLN 1 BILLION


Scope of support: construction or reconstruction of roads and revitalisation of railway lines.

Investments important for the development of railway and road transport in Pomorskie Region are implemented:

- railway lines currently lines No. 207 Grudziądz

 Malbork and No. 405 Szczecinek Ustka are being revitalised. Additionally, on the line of Fast City Rail
 No. 250 from Gdańsk Śródmieście to Rumia, an integrated safety monitoring and passenger information management system is being put into practice, together with modernisation of a building of the Suburban Railway Station in Gdynia Główna and 8 platforms on this route,
- regional roads currently under reconstruction are Voivodeship Roads No. 222 Gdańsk-Starogard Gdański, 222 and 229 from Starogard Gdański through Jabłowo to the interchange of A1 motorway, 224 Godziszewo - interchange of A1 motorway "Stanisławie", 521 Kwidzyn-Prabuty, 188 Człuchów - Debrzno, 226 "Rusocin" interchange of A1 motorway - Pruszcz Gdański and Pruszcz Gdański - Przejazdowo and 214 Łeba - Białogarda, together with construction of a by-pass road around Wicko and construction of a by-pass road by Kartuzy along Voivodeship Road No. 211.

ENERGY-EFFICIENT RETROFITTING OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS

67 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 704.4 MILLION

Scope of support: comprehensive thermal modernisation of public utility buildings.

Examples of projects:

- comprehensive energy-efficient retrofitting of 14 municipal residential buildings in Gdynia. The value of the investment amounts to PLN 11.3 million,
- thermal modernisation of 49 public utility facilities located in the Functional Urban Area of Słupsk, e.g. schools, common rooms and fire stations (decreasing demand for thermal energy by over 57%).
- The value of the investment amounts to PLN 40.2 million, thermal modernisation of 13 buildings forming part of the post-Cistercian cathedral complex located in the "Historic Monument in Pelplin" area (thorough thermal modernisation, replacement of heat sources, co-generation, monitoring of energy, use of Renewable Energy Sources in the form of heat pumps and photovoltaic installations).
 - 2 projects with a value of PLN 70.1 million

LOANS FOR ENERGY-EFFICIENT RETROFITTING AND RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES

The Board of Pomorskie Region has signed an agreement with the European Investment Bank (EIB) with a value of over PLN 284 mln. These funds are allocated for repayable support of investments concerning thermal modernisation of residential buildings and generation of energy from renewable sources. The EIB will select financial intermediaries which, in turn, will offer loans to final recipients - e.g. to local self-governments, entrepreneurs, housing associations or housing cooperatives.



ENERGY-SAVING LIGHTING

18 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 88.9 MILLION

Scope of support: modernisation of external lighting to be replaced with energy-saving lighting.

Examples of projects:

- improving the effectiveness of external lighting systems in the Functional Area of the City of Słupsk. The project's value amounts to PLN 28.7 million,
- modernisation of external lighting to be replaced with energy-saving lighting in the area of the Hewelianum Centre in Gdańsk, with the use of an associated energy management system. The value of the project amounts to PLN 1.3 million.
- replacement of light fittings in the Functional Urban Area of Starogard Gdański. The value of the project amounts to PLN 7.2 million.


MODERNISATION OF HEAT NETWORKS AND BOILER-ROOMS

8 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 67.7 MILLION

Scope of support: reconstruction of centralised heat supply systems and modernisation of existing heat sources.

- construction of a heat network together with heat distribution centres in Potegowo municipality. The project's value amounts to PLN 9.2 million,
- reduction of emissions in Skórcz through reconstruction of existing installations to be replaced by highly efficient co-generation and construction of a heat network. The value of the project amounts to PLN 18.7 million,
- construction and modernisation of a heat network and heat distribution centres in Kwidzyn. The value of the project amounts to PLN 18.3 million.







THE OBJECTIVE OF SUPPORT WITHIN AXIS 11 - THE ENVIRONMENT IS PROTECTION OF NATURAL RESOURCES THROUGH A FLOOD PROTECTION SYSTEM FOR THE REGION, EFFECTIVE MUNICIPAL WASTE MANAGEMENT. PUTTING WATER AND SEWAGE MANAGEMENT IN ORDER AND PROTECTION OF BIODIVERSITY.

WATER AND SEWAGE MANAGEMENT

26 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF OVER PLN 230.7 MILLION

Scope of support: investments in combined sewer system networks, sewage treatment plants, reconstruction of water pipe networks, creation and extension of water quality monitoring and assessment systems, sewage sludge management infrastructure.

Examples of projects:

- construction of sanitary sewage networks, extension and reconstruction of a water pipe network for Cieciorka. Dabrowa and Iwiczno, together with extension of the sewage treatment plant in Kaliska. The value of the project amounts to PLN 20.5 million.
- construction of sanitary sewage networks in Grabiny Zameczek and Krzywe Koło together with extension of the sewage treatment plant in Suchy Dab.

• The value of the investment amounts to PLN 19.5 million, improvement of quality and reduction of water losses in the Central Żuławy Supply System. The value of the project amounts to PLN 51.3 million.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

9 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF OVER PLN 9.2 MILLION

Scope of support: creation of Points for Selective Collection of Waste in municipalities.

Implemented projects:

Within agreements signed so far, the creation of Points for Selective Collection of Municipal Waste has been financed in the following municipalities: Skarszewy, Gniew, Cewice, Karsin, Dzierzgoń, Miastko, Dziemiany, Lipnica, Tuchomie, Stare Pole, Ustka and in the city of Lebork.





18 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 89.5 MILLION

Scope of support: protection of biodiversity in landscape parks and nature reserves, creation of ecological education centres, education of residents in environmental protection and prevention of climatic changes, development and protection of green areas in cities.

Examples of projects:

- protection of protected areas of particular forest sections from Mikoszewo to Krynica Morska.
 The value of the project amounts to PLN 12.5 million,
- protection of endangered species and promotion of biodiversity through creation of the EcoPark of the University of Gdańsk, The value of the project amounts to almost PLN 3 million.


• a project of the Voivodeship Environmental Protection and Water Management Fund in Gdańsk with a value of PLN 2.8 million, concerning the protection of 3 species of plants and 2 types of eco-systems in 18 nature reserves.

REDUCTION OF NATURAL HAZARDS

21 PROJECTS WITH A VALUE OF PLN 138.7 MILLION

Scope of support: extension of infrastructure necessary for strengthening protection of residents against floods, purchase of equipment for rescue services, creation or extension of monitoring and warning systems, construction of new or increased capacity of existing storage reservoirs.

- construction of rain water sewage system and storage reservoirs in Pruszcz Gdański. The value of the project amounts to PLN 12.5 million,
- improvement of flood safety of Żuławy region through extension of the alarm and notification system and purchase of specialist rescue equipment.
 - The value of the project amounts to PLN 3.7 million,
- support of the rescue system and crisis management in Kartuski county by buying specialist equipment for the needs of units of the National Rescue and Extinguishing System. The value of the investment amounts to almost PLN 2 million.
